



Bolivar Peninsula Special Utility District Board of Directors Seeks To Fill Positions

Bolivar Peninsula Special Utility District's Board of Directors is seeking interested candidates to consider for appointment to vacated positions on the Board. There are currently two positions available to be filled. If interested in filling one of these positions, please apply at the District office by **August 14, 2009**. The term for both of these positions is until November 2010. It is recommended that a resume be submitted with your application for an appointment.

Additionally, the District's Board of Directors' election will be held Nov. 3, 2009. There are four Board positions up for election and the positions are elected at large. Qualified individuals may place their name on the ballot to run for one of these positions by submitting an application by the final date to file on **September 2, 2009**.

Qualifications for a Board Member are as follows:

1. You must be at least 18 years old.
2. You must be a resident of Texas and have resided in the State for 12 continuous months, and
3. You must be one of the following:
 - A property owner of the Bolivar Peninsula, or
 - A registered voter of the Bolivar Peninsula, or
 - A user of the facilities (receive water from the District).

If interested in an appointment and/or for a place on the ballot, please come by the District office located at 1840 Highway 87 and Kahla Drive in Crystal Beach (in the trailer next to the drive-thru). The application is available at the District office during business hours (Monday – Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) and is available on the District's webpage at www.bpsud.com. ***Please note that a separate application must be submitted for consideration of an appointment and for a place on the November ballot.***
